During construction Rite Aid had continued operations. A temporary demising wall was installed to separate the spaces until the new expansion area was completed



To have this project completed within the limited time frame, an open platform of communication between Shannon Construction Company, the store manager, and the project manager was essential.

All finishes and lighting fixtures had to match exactly on both sides of the store to give the illusion the entire store had been completed renovated.
